Sermon Notes
“The Fiery Furnace”
Daniel 3:1-30
(p. 875 in The Pew Bible)

Have you ever been told to do something that you knew was wrong, that violated your moral and spiritual convictions? Have you ever been threatened that if you did not do what you were told to do, you would face serious, perhaps even life threatening repercussions? That’s precisely what happened to Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. In response to King Nebuchadnezzar’s demand that they worship the golden image he had erected, we will discover this morning that:

- they wouldn’t _____ down before the statue (verses 1-12)
- they wouldn’t _____ to the demands of the king (verses 13 & 18)
- they wouldn’t _____ in the fiery furnace (verses 19 & 30)

Luke 21:12 & 19

It describes an event that took place in Babylon with implications for our own day and time right here in America. The sermon is entitled “The Writing on the Wall.”
